

Minutes ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 13 July 2025, 10:30am, Acacia Hall

- 1. Welcome Brian Duguid opened the meeting.
- 2. Apologies No apologies were received.
- **3.** A **Quorum** was reached: 15 proxies were received, 50 members were in attendance, exceeding the required quorum of 63 by 2 members. There were 6 regulars (not yet members).
- **4. Minutes of previous AGM** had been distributed prior to the meeting via email and on the church's website. Minutes accepted as a true reflection of last year's AGM.
- **5.** The **2024/25 Annual Report** was made available on the church website prior to the meeting.

A special thanks was extended to **Mandisa Makasi** for compiling the professional report and to **Lynne Jones** for editing and proofreading.

The Chairman's Report was taken as read, with the following highlights noted by **Brian Duguid**:

• Leadership Changes:

- Senior Pastor Nick Bekker resigned and left at the end of September 2024 to take up a post at Karratha Baptist Church in Australia.
- Church Administrator Trish Bekker concluded her role at HCC in December 2024.
- The congregation continues to pray for the Bekker family as they await Australian residency approval.

• New Appointments:

- Ryan Jones was appointed Senior Pastor effective 1 October 2024, following unanimous support at a Special General Meeting on 25 August 2024. His wife, Lynne Jones, has also actively engaged in church ministries.
- Will Rudling and Daniel Nyoni were appointed as elders at the same Special General Meeting.
- o Andrew Copeland joined the eldership in February 2025 after Paul King stepped down.
- o **Siyanda Yaka** was appointed as **Next Gen Youth Director** and also serves on the eldership in his pastoral capacity.

• Eldership Transitions:

- Will Rudling will be stepping down as elder due to relocation to the Western Cape in July 2025.
- o Margie Klein and Brian Duguid announced their intention to step down from eldership. Tacit approval of new elder nominations will be tabled at this AGM as per the church constitution.

 A heartfelt thanks was given to Margie Klein for her nearly 19.5 years of faithful service, including her leadership on the original steering committee prior to the planting of HCC in 2006.

Administration and Operations:

- o Mandisa Makasi assumed the role of Church Administrator in December 2024 and was thanked for her energy and commitment.
- Debbie Kreft, church treasurer, stepped down due to work and family commitments. Thanks were extended for her four years of faithful service.
- Peter Rigby has taken over the role of church treasurer. He will present the 2024/25 financial highlights. We are grateful to Peter ,once again, for agreeing to serve as church treasurer.

Church Financial Position:

 HCC continues to reflect a healthy financial position as per the latest audited financials (year ending 28 February 2025). The church gives thanks for God's ongoing provision.

• Venue and Partnership:

- Appreciation was expressed for continued use of Acacia Hall and the broader HeronBridge College facilities.
- Gratitude was extended to Mr. Kenneth Checkley and Curro Holdings Ltd. for ongoing support.
- Siyanda Yaka is actively developing partnerships between the church and college, especially in Youth/Young Adults ministry.

Future Location Discussion:

 The church has decided not to pursue relocation at this stage, following strategy sessions held in January–February 2025 and an Exco meeting on 27 May 2025.
 This decision may be revisited in the future.

• In Memoriam:

o The church mourned the passing of **Clive Douglas** (April 2025), a long-time member and founding Chair of Council, and his wife **Cynthia Douglas** (2024), a founding elder. Their legacy and Christian witness were honoured.

Thanks to Volunteers and Ministry Leads:

 Deep appreciation was extended to all elders, ministry leads, and congregational members who serve week after week, enabling the church's "pop-up" model to function.

6. Treasurer's Report

Peter Rigby was invited to provide an overview of the **audited annual financial statements** for the year ended **28 February 2025**. Key highlights included:

- Cash and cash equivalents: R1.492 million
- Surplus for the year: R119,000 (vs. R142,000 in 2024)
- Tithes: Flat year-on-year at R1.840 million
- Expenses: R1.777 million (vs. R1.725 million in 2024), reflecting a **3% increase** The church continues to reflect a **stable and healthy financial position**, and thanks were expressed for the Lord's continued provision.

7. Confirmation of Eldership Appointments

In accordance with the church constitution and eldership processes, the following appointments were tabled for **tacit approval by the congregation**:

- o Andrew Copeland Invited to join the eldership in March 2025
- o Tony Verwey Nominated and confirmed by the existing eldership
- o **Siyanda Yaka** Appointed as **Next Gen Director** and, in line with the church constitution, automatically joins the eldership as a **pastor of the church**

A show of hands was conducted by the congregation, and tacit approval was confirmed for all listed appointments.
